Dressage will run on Saturday and the jumping phases will run on Sunday.

**Jumping Phase:** Will be held on our all-weather arena. There will be show jumps followed by a variety of working hunter and portable cross country fences. An optimum time will be set for the full course. The rider should proceed immediately from the show jumps to the cross country jumps; there will be no second bell. Body protectors must be worn.

Jumping faults will be added to the dressage score. The winner will be the rider with the lowest score which has been accumulated over the two phases.

**Dress code:** Dressage phase as for British Eventing and cross country attire for the jumping phase.

**Penalties:**

Knock Down:	4 penalties
First Refusal	4 penalties
Second Refusal	8 penalties
Third Refusal	Elimination
Fall of horse or rider	Compulsory retirement

Time faults will be added for rounds over and below the optimum time.

**Prizes:** Rosettes up to sixth place and Prize Vouchers up to third place although this will be dependant on the number of entries. Classes may be divided into sections dependant on number of entries. Times will be available on our website on the Thursday prior to the competition.
