

UNAFFILIATED DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS

**Saturday 6th March P4, P10, N25, N26, E42 (UK Riders
Challenge 2010 Qualifier)**



In the Walk and Trot tests in November and February riders may wear what they wish but hats are, of course, compulsory. There are no restrictions on horses' tack in the Walk and Trot tests.

Tests will be those produced by BD.

Prizes: Rosettes up to 6th place and vouchers up to 3rd place to the value of £13, £8 and £5 although this will be dependant on the number of entries in the classes.

All entries are £10 per class. Please make cheques payable to Eland Lodge Equestrian Ltd. Should there be less than 4 junior riders in any class they will be combined with the appropriate Senior class. This will not affect their ability to qualify for the UK Riders Challenge 2010 as Juniors and Seniors will be split for this purpose. On 6th March all tests are qualifiers.

Restricted Preliminary Classes: Combination of horse and rider are not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any class last season nor have any BD points.

Open Preliminary Classes: Combinations not to have more than 49 BD points.

Restricted Novice Classes: Combinations are not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any Novice class last season nor have any BD points.

Open Novice Classes: Combinations not to have more than 124 BD points.

Restricted Elementary Classes: Combinations are not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any Elementary class last season nor have any BD points.

Open Elementary Classes: Combinations not to have more than 199 BD points.

SIDE SADDLE RIDERS:

Area 12 of the Side Saddle Association will provide rosettes to sixth place for the tests with the highest percentages of the day ridden side saddle. Side saddle riders may enter any class and also have the opportunity to gain a placing amongst the astride riders.
